





# RUST COLLEGE ATHLETICS RECEIVE 2021-2022 CHAMPIONS OF CHARACTER FIVE-STAR INSTITUTION SILVER AWARD

Rust College is one of 157 National Association of Intercollegiate Athletics (NAIA) member institutions who won a Champions of Character Five-Star Award for 2021-2022.

The NAIA measures institutions on their demonstrated commitment to the NAIA Champions of Character program which is designed to help coaches, players, and parents find balance by keeping five core values at the heart of the athletic experience: integrity, respect, responsibility, sportsmanship, and servant leadership.

According to Jarvis Stephen, Rust College alum and first-year Athletic Director, receiving the Silver Level Award was "earned" because of the work put in by the athletic staff and students. Institutions earn points based on exceptional student-athlete grade point averages and by having minimal to no ejections during competition throughout the course of the academic year.

The Bearcats are committed to advancing character-driven athletics. Stephen says next year, "we're getting the gold."


