For the 2nd year, Rust College is participating in the "Retool Your School" Campaign and every vote counts. Since 2009, Home Depot has continued to increase its investment in campus improvements for historically Black colleges and universities ensuring that students have an upgraded environment that enhances their educational experience. A total of 30 grants will be awarded this year.

HBCUs are separated into three clusters based on student population. The top ten schools with the most votes per cluster will receive grants ranging from \$40,000 to \$150,000. Rust College is in Cluster 3 and our goal is to be awarded the \$150,000 grant.






